# Set Designer

A **set designer** is in charge of designing and creating the **sets** that appear in films, on television programmes as well as in the theatre. The role involves working and communicating with directors, producers, **costume designers** and other members of staff. Typical responsibilities include: reading scripts.

Create a stage plan for set design – you could create more than one to show different scenes: Outside the factory, inside the factory, Charlie's house.
